Waimauku School encourages students to be caring and responsible dog owners. On Ag Day students can demonstrate their skills and knowledge of dog care and handling in a friendly, competitive environment.

If you want to enter your dog on Ag Day you need to register them on Kindo by 14 October

You need to be 10 or older to enter your dog on Ag Day and one of your parents or a caregiver must be with you at the judging.



Please remember that only dogs who are competing can come to Ag Day

SHOWING YOUR DOG ON AG DAY

The dog competition will be a chance to show how well you have trained your dog to sit, stay, walk nicely on the lead and come to you when you call them.

The judge might also ask you a question about how you care for your dog.

There will be placegetter ribbons and a trophy for the winning handler and their dog.

Please don't bring your dog if it is reactive (gets angry or scared) around other dogs, kids or loud noises.

TIPS

- Try to exercise your dog in the morning before Ag Day starts, this will help them be a good dog
- Using treats when you are training your dog is a great idea

On Ag Day your dog will need a secure lead and collar so you can tie it up on the concrete court by the Senior Block. A parent will need to stay with your dog.

When you arrive at school come to the office and collect a number tag (around 8:30am)
