13. Pizza Days – Plan for the week of year 5 and 6 school camp in November. PTA could then utilise the kitchen for logistics.
Only sell three flavours of Pizza
Pepperoni, Hawaiian and Cheese \$2 a slice
Offer only one Gluten free option being Cheese at additional cost \$2.50
Sell on kindo
Pizza cost
Hawaiian \$7
Simply Cheese \$5.50
Pepperoni \$5.50
Gluten free simply cheese \$9.49
8 slices per pizza aim for \$8 Profit a pizza, this allows for small slices and giving teachers leftovers for free.
Logistics would be for junior school roughly 45 pizzas if each child has one slice.
With smaller split of older years first day without 4 rooms going to camp would be roughly 75 pizzas this is assuming an average of 2 slices per child.
Second senior day with roughly 80 children would be roughly 20 pizzas.
With these assumptions expected profit would be \$1120. The day however is more for giving the kids a treat than actual profit.
